General Information

The forthcoming Maltese Presidency of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe has the honour to welcome you to Malta and is pleased to provide you this practical information note (PIN) on the logistical modalities to help you prepare for delegations' participation in the Congress Bureau Meeting, the Side-Event and the Multilevel Governance Conference, taking place on the Island of Gozo, Malta on the 12th and 13th June 2025.

1. Venues

The Congress Bureau Meeting and the Side-Event Women in Politics Seminar will be held at the Gozo Cittadella Cultural Centre https://visitgozo.com/places/cittadella/ in Victoria – Gozo, Malta on the 12th June 2025, whereas the Multilevel Governance Conference on Approaches to Address Environmental Challenges will be held at Il-Kappella Hall, Kempinski Hotel San Lawrenz https://www.kempinski.com/en/hotel-san-lawrenz/meetings-events in St. Laurence – Gozo.

2. Accreditation

Delegations will be kindly asked to register via the online accreditation system. A link to the system will be forwarded shortly.

Kindly note that venue will be accessible to registered participants only. Ad-hoc accreditation at the venue will not be provided.

Participants should have a valid badge that must be presented at the entrance of the Conference venue and other rooms that will be in use during the conference. The badge should be worn in a visible manner at all times, when at the Conference venue, including at the reception.

Badges will be issued upon arrival at the venue's registration desk. Participants are requested to present their passport or ID card at the registration desk. To avoid delays with the issuance of badges, please arrive well in advance. The registration desk will be open from 0815hrs. It is important to note that registration for the meeting does not automatically imply that hotel reservations are made. Therefore, delegations must make their own hotel bookings.

7. Transport

Between the 11th and 14th June organised transport will be available from Malta International Airport to the recommended hotels in Gozo (Kempinski San Lawrenz Hotel, Hotel Ta' Cenc Resort and Spa, The Grand Hotel, Hotel Calypso and St. Patrick's Hotel), from the recommended hotels to the venue/s, from the venue/s to the recommended hotels and from the recommended hotels or venue to the Malta International Airport.

Delegates opting to stay in other hotels or other localities may still avail themselves of transport by making their way to one of the recommended hotels.

For logistical and operational efficiency, the online accreditation system will require each delegate to provide their arrival and departure dates and times, along with the corresponding flight numbers and details of their chosen hotel accommodation.

During the registration process, delegates who opt to stay at alternative hotels or in different localities are kindly requested to inform us if they wish to make use of the organised transportation. Should they choose to do so, they are also asked to specify from which of the recommended hotels they would prefer to be collected.

8. Visa Requirements

Delegates who require a visa to travel to Malta are required to apply for such visa on time. Prior to their departure, travellers are required to ensure that they have a valid passport which expires at least six months after their date of departure.

9. General Information

9.1 Electricity voltage

The electricity supply in Malta is 230 volts. The square-fitting standard three-pin, 13 Amp British plugs and sockets are used. A step-down transformer is needed to convert the current to 110-120V. Delegates are advised to bring their own electrical adaptors if required.

9.2 Weather in Malta

The climate in Malta is subtropical Mediterranean, with long, hot, dry and very sunny summers and short, mild and slightly rainy winters. Weather during the month of June is expected to be warm and sunny with average temperatures of around 25 degrees celsius, which could reach 30 degrees celsius.

9.3 Banking Services and Currency

Malta's official currency is the euro. Banking hours are generally Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 17:00. Some banks are open on Saturday mornings. Most internationally recognised currencies and traveller's cheques can be exchanged at commercial banks and at Malta International Airport.

Cash dispensing machines or ATMs are located throughout the country, and major credit and debit cards are widely accepted. ATMs are also located at some hotels.

9.4 International Dialling Codes

The international dialling code for Malta is +356. International calls made from Malta should be preceded by 00, followed by the national country code.

9.5 Time Zone

Malta is on Central European Time (CET), which is one hour ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

9.6 Medical Help

The number 112 can be used for all emergencies.
